

### 3. The history of the creation – Part 2

Last Sunday we studied part 1 of the history of the Creation – starting from Day 1, God creating light from nothing, to Day 4, creating sun, moon, and all the stars in the universe out of nothing. He is not done yet. He is on a roll.

Before we get to Day 5 and 6, I need to state a couple of very important facts that you must keep in mind:

**1) The evolutionary scientists who insist on their fairy tale theory of evolution cannot and don't want to explain the Second Law of Thermodynamics in connection with the evolution.**

According to their evolution, the things should get better, not worse; the things should be evolving from simple to more complex. But by the definition of the Second Law of the Thermodynamics which is a system's energy gradually decreases, resulting in disorder or randomness – a state called entropy. Over time, entropy (disorder) increases in any closed system without new infusions of energy. Everything tends toward a state of disorder over time.

In simple layman's terms, the thing gets worse, not better, if it is not intervened by an outer source. An excellent example is Sun. All the astrophysicists admit that it is getting cooler and smaller.

It is an absolute obstacle that they cannot overcome. So, instead of admitting that their evolution theory is a hoax, they ignore the Second Law of the Thermodynamics. This brings the second point.

**2) Why can the evolution scientists not find the fact of the Creation by God? It's the same reason a thief cannot find a policeman. They simply don't want to. These are the people who embrace the Climate Change mumbo jumbo.**

#### A. DAY 5 – SEA CREATURES AND BIRDS IN THE AIR

*Genesis 1:20-23 Then God said, "Let the waters abound with an abundance of living creatures, and let birds fly above the earth across the face of the firmament of the heavens." 21 So God created great sea creatures and every living thing that moves, with which the waters abounded, according to their kind, and every winged bird according to its kind. And God saw that it was good. 22 And God blessed them, saying, "Be fruitful and multiply, and fill the waters in the seas, and let birds multiply on the earth." 23 So the evening and the morning were the fifth day.*

I asked you to underline "according to its kind". This phrase appears 10 times in Genesis chapter 1. It means God allows variation within a kind, but something of one kind will never develop into anything of another kind.

The evolutionists love to talk about "Microevolution" that they consider as a stepping stone to "Macroevolution." For example, the structure among dogs is diverse. The chihuahua is very different from the Great Dane in outer look, but they are both dogs inside. However, they will NOT become mice or cat, no matter how much breeding is done.

Evolutionists often give convincing examples of Microevolution, the variation of a kind within its kind, adapting to the environment. For example, the ratio of black to white

peppered moths may increase when their environment makes it easier for dark moths to escape detection. Or finches may develop different beaks in response to their distinctive environment. But the moths are still moths, and the finches are still finches. There has been no change outside of the kind. Microevolution does not prove macroevolution.

## **B. DAY 6 – ANIMALS ON THE EARTH AND CREATION OF MANKIND**

*Genesis 1:24-25 Then God said, "Let the earth bring forth the living creature according to its kind: cattle and creeping thing and beast of the earth, each according to its kind"; and it was so. 25 And God made the beast of the earth according to its kind, cattle according to its kind, and everything that creeps on the earth according to its kind. And God saw that it was good.*

Most people are unaware that Darwin's strongest opponents were not Christians, but fossil experts. Darwin admitted the state of the fossil evidence was "the most obvious and gravest objection which can be urged against my theory."

The fossil record is marked by 2 great principles:

### **1) Stasis – It means most species are unchanged in all their documented history.**

The way they look when they first appear in the fossil record is the way they look when last appearing in the fossil record. They have not changed.

### **2) Sudden appearance – It explains in any local area, a species does not arise gradually, but appears all at once and "fully formed."**

If evolution carries the gradual change of one kind of organism into another kind, the outstanding characteristic of the fossil record is the absence of evidence for evolution.

By the way, if you've ever wondered which came first egg or chicken, it was chicken.

*Genesis 1:26-28 Then God said, "Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness; let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over the cattle, over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth." 27 So God created man in His own image; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them. 28 Then God blessed them, and God said to them, "Be fruitful and multiply; fill the earth and subdue it; have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over every living thing that moves on the earth."*

In many verses in the OT in which God refers to Himself using a plural noun of the Hebrew word "Elohim," one of the primary titles of God in the OT that is occurring over 2,500 times.

We can rule out polytheism – belief in multiple gods, because that would contradict countless other Scripture verses that tell us that God is one and that there is only one God. 3 times in Isaiah 45 alone, God states, "I am the LORD, and there is no other; there is no God besides Me."

Since the Bible, and the NT especially, presents God as a Trinity, Genesis 1:26 can only represent a conversation within the Trinity. God the Father is having a "conversation" with God the Son and God the Holy Spirit. The OT hints at the plurality of God, and the NT clarifies this plurality with the doctrine of the Trinity. Obviously, there is no way we can fully understand how the Trinity works, but God has given us

enough information to know that He does exist in three Persons – Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

The mankind was created in God's image. This brings 3 points we must understand:

**1) This means there is an unbridgeable gap between human life and animal life.**

Though we are biologically similar to certain animals, we are distinct in our moral, intellectual, and spiritual capabilities.

**2) This means Jesus' incarnation was truly possible.**

Jesus, God in the Second Person of the Trinity could really become man, because although deity and humanity are not the same, they are compatible.

**3) This means humans possess spirituality.**

Man is made for communion with God. It is on the level of spirit, we communicate with God. No animals, no trees, no other created beings have this privilege and spirit.

You may ask, "Didn't the archaeologists discover the primitive cavemen's skulls and bones?" Yes and no. The theory "Nebraska Man" was constructed on the basis of a pig's tooth. They didn't actually find the entire skull. Out of a pig's tooth, several evolutionists came up with the diagram of the Nebraska Man. The theory of "Piltdown Man" was also built around a modern ape's jaw. Another hoax.

For a long time the evolutionists were beaming over the discovery of the "Neanderthal Man." They thought that this primitive man was the missing link between modern man and apelike creatures. Because this primitive man was a little slouch in form. He had brow ridges, bulb-shaped forehead, sloping shoulders, bowed-legs and other so-called 'primitive' features.

But the other scientists like Dr. Francis Ivanhoe found out that the Neanderthal Man's primitive features were due to softening of his bones and other pathological conditions caused by his severe Vitamin D deficiency; cripple him further with arthritis. If the Neanderthal Man could speak from his grave, he would say, "I was not a cave-man. I was just hurting."

Let's go back to v27:

*Genesis 1:27 So God created man in His own image; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them.*

You might say that the pinnacle of God's creative work was His creation of humans. We as human beings stand apart from all the rest of God's creation, because we have been uniquely created in the image of God Himself. He made us, both male and female, to be more like Him than anything else He made.

What does the Bible mean when it says that man is created in God's image? Does this mean that when we get to heaven, we will discover that God looks just like us? No, rather, there are other dimensions to being made in the image of God.

**1) There is a recognition built within us that there is more to life than simple existence. There is a spiritual dimension. God has set eternity in our hearts.**

*Ecclesiastes 3:11 He has made everything beautiful in its time. Also He has put eternity in their hearts, except that no one can find out the work that God does from beginning to end.*

**2) We have a built-in sense of morality.** The apostle Paul tells us that even unbelievers have the work of the law written in their hearts, and their consciences bear witness.

*Romans 2:14-15 for when Gentiles, who do not have the law, by nature do the things in the law, these, although not having the law, are a law to themselves, 15 who show the work of the law written in their hearts, their conscience also bearing witness, and between themselves their thoughts accusing or else excusing them)*

The man knew God. But man did not want to know God or honor Him as God. The man was willing to use God's gifts, but he was not willing to worship and praise God for His gifts and even acknowledge His presence. The result was an empty mind and a darkened heart.

It is estimated that we have over 100 billion neurons – also called nerve cells or brain cells, which is about the number of stars in the Milky Way Galaxy. Here are also trillions of supportive cells in the brain called “glia.” Each neuron is connected to other neurons by up to 40,000 individual synapses between cells. Multiplying 100 billion neurons times 40,000 synapses is equivalent to the brain having more connections in it than there are stars in the universe. A piece of brain tissue the size of a grain of sand contains 100,000 neurons and 1 billion synapses, all “talking” to one another.

The Lord Jesus put His signature in human bodies everywhere when He created us:

*Colossians 1:16-17 For by him all things were created: things in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or powers or rulers or authorities; all things were created by him and for him. He is before all things, and in him all things hold together. NIV*

There is a protein molecule called “Laminin.” Cells are organized in certain molecular structures. That controls what protein they are. Scientists are guessing that there are 10,000–16,000 proteins in a human body. Laminin is vital to making sure over-all body structures hold together. Improper production of laminin can cause muscles to form improperly. Would you like to see Jesus' signature in your bodies? This is the one which holds our bodies together. Can anyone tell me that it has nothing to do with the Lord Jesus?

*Genesis 1:29-31 And God said, “See, I have given you every herb that yields seed which is on the face of all the earth, and every tree whose fruit yields seed; to you it shall be for food. 30 Also, to every beast of the earth, to every bird of the air, and to everything that creeps on the earth, in which there is life, I have given every green herb for food”; and it was so. 31 Then God saw everything that He had made, and indeed it was very good. So the evening and the morning were the sixth day.*

God gave man dominion over the whole earth, but only vegetation is specifically mentioned as being for food. Seemingly, before the flood, the human race was vegetarian, but after the flood, man was given permission to eat the flesh of animals according to Genesis 9:3. From what we have learned in the Book of Revelation, we are going to go back to a vegetarian diet in heaven. So chow down on that 16 oz. T-bone steak while you can.

**1) In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth. Believe it by faith.**

Whether you believe it or not, that is the truth. And that truth remains.
