Muslim Outreach Ministry

History and Ministry:

Mendu and Seniha Veliev were muslims who live in Shumen, Bulgaria. Here is his account of the work that they have been doing for the Kingdom of God:

I, Mendu, have put my trust in the Lord in 1984. One year later, my wife, Seniha started to believe in the Lord Jesus Christ, too. My father wanted to kill us, because we have started believing in Jesus and we have left our former faith Islam. Our relatives started hating us as well, because we have become Christians. We have been through a lot of difficulties and we are thankful to the Lord that He gave us strength to stay firm and keep our faith.

Praise the Lord that now my father, my sister and her husband, the parents of my wife and some other relatives believe in Jesus.

In 1990 God has sent us in a small town to serve Him. For a year and a half we worked for the Lord there and with God's help we have found a small church there. After that we transferred that church in the hands of one family as the Lord called us to the different location.

In 1994 during one church service, the Lord spoke to me and my wife, at the same time, to go and serve among our native – the muslims. We obeyed to His call. Since then we have been serving among the muslims. We started to evangelize in the Turkish villages. We have visited about 18 villages and we have given to the people the Gospel tracks and some brochures. We were invited to go to pray for sick people at hospitals and people's houses. Many young families for whom the doctors have said that they can not have children. But the Lord bless them with children. God has done many miracles and healings among the muslims. Praise be to His name!

In 1999 I was on a missionary work in Kazahstan. In 2002 my wife and I went twice in Macedonia for a missionary trip among the muslims. Now we are visiting 6 villages. We are meeting in people's homes. My wife works with the children and teaches Bibles for the women. We work with different families to help them grow spiritually, too.

Several times we were threatened. Twice the tires of our car were slashed. But praise the Lord that He keeps us safe from everything.

We see that the Lord wants to use us in this direction – to go and proclaim the Gospel and found churches and make followers of God among the muslims.


