

19. How to use BlueLetterBible web site

www.BlueLetterBible.org is a FREE web site that provides a tremendous amount of Bible information.

I personally use this site often for my study.

I'd like to share with you how I get around in this web site to learn more about the Lord's speaking Word – the Bible.

1) Type in a verse (s) or word (s) in the first blank area.

2) Select your Bible version.

3) Click "Search".

4) If you want to see some cross referencing verses, click the icon 'K'.

5) Then you will have 'Treasury of Scripture Knowledge' that covers just about every word with cross-reference verses.

6) If you want to look into Greek or Hebrew words, click the icon 'C'.

7) Notice the numbers in the middle column? It is a Strong's Exhaustive number. When you click it, you will have all these:

You get to have original word in Greek or Hebrew on the top, English spelling below.

If you click the Pronunciation triangle icon, you will hear how to pronounce the word in Greek or Hebrew.

Underneath that, you will see the root word for the Greek or Hebrew word.

It even provides you a Lexicon definition. I love this page. It totally rocks.

8) If you are looking for commentaries, you don't need to go any further. Just click "L". Viola! You have more than enough here.

10) "What about a Bible dictionary?" No problemo. They've got you covered. Click 'D', you will have several dictionaries and Nave's Topical Dictionary as well.
